CODE OF CONDUCT

Green Hills values the experience of every guest during their visit. We developed this Code of Conduct to clearly communicate the behavior expectation of each individual to ensure your safety and privacy while you spend time here.

All persons entering the park must display proper respect for the deceased and for the sacred grounds in which they are interred (buried). Violations could result in permanent exclusion from visiting.

Although every aspect of our Code is equally important, we would like to highlight the following items as crucial to the enjoyment for all who visit. We ask that you comply at all times.



No person may possess or consume alcoholic beverages, smoke marijuana or use or possess illegal drugs on property.



No person may use any device which projects amplified sound or music. This would include, but not limited to, Car Radios, Bluetooth Speakers, Cell Phones.



No E-Z Up canopies or similar tents at any time.



No Sporting Activities on the premises. Playing sports imposes on those around you and ultimately diminishes their peaceful visit.

Signs have been placed throughout the property for your convenience. Scan the QR Code to access all rules from your mobile device.



CODE OF CONDUCT

- No Motor Homes or Recreational Vehicles.
- Removing Flowers or Decorations from any interment site not belonging to you is a crime and will be prosecuted.
- Vehicles must remain on paved roads and use designated entry points. No vehicles on walkways, grass areas or undeveloped ground.
- Any person found on the premises after the Park is closed will be deemed as trespassing. Local authorities will be contacted and requested to enforce such law.
- Respect for other guests is expected. Please refrain from setting up chairs or tables that extend onto any surrounding interment sites.
- Please refrain from landscaping, watering or any other maintenance. Contact us for all work order concerns.



No use of propane stove tops or barbeques.



No personal umbrella over 48" in diameter are permitted.



Balloon releases are NOT allowed at any time.




Photography and filming are prohibited without prior approval by Green Hills. The privacy of those interred is a responsibility we honor to those who have entrusted us.

Mariachi or similar music groups are **Only** allowed when planned in advance with a Green Hills representative for a Funeral Service. All unplanned situations are not allowed and will be stopped immediately.



Violators of our Code will be removed from the Park immediately. Continued violations will result in permanent exclusion from Green Hills.



SAFETY RULES

Security - (310) 995-7006

- Opportunity creates a thief, so as you prepare to leave your car, take a good look around to see if anyone is watching. Ensure you completely lock your car and ideally remove any valuables or at least hide them from view. Better still, leave your valuables at home.
- If you see behavior that looks suspicious, report it immediately to Security by calling (310) 995-7006.
- Drive motor vehicles in the Park at a speed of 15 mph or less and park on roadways. Anyone speeding will be asked to leave immediately.
- No climbing or disturbing monuments, walls and fences.
- Report to Security if anyone is using skateboards, bicycles, roller blades and roller skates.
- The water features throughout the Park are popular areas to enjoy. The water can be a hazard as some are several feet deep. Children should be supervised at all times when near water. The rocks are decorative and should not be picked up or thrown into the water.
- While feeding the ducks is allowed, please use the food provided by Green Hills. Our Guest Services Booth has supplies on hand. Do not throw trash or other debris in the water.
- The Park is a natural habitat for wildlife, including coyotes. Do not feed the animals and be cautious of your surroundings.
- Guests under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

We're committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all visitors.

We kindly ask that you stay mindful of your surroundings and follow these safety guidelines:

Stay Aware: Be mindful of uneven surfaces, steps, or pathways, especially in outdoor areas.

Supervise Children: For their safety, please keep children close and under supervision at all times.

Report Concerns: If you notice anything unusual or have safety concerns, don't hesitate to inform security immediately.

Your well-being is important to us, and we appreciate your cooperation in making our space safe and enjoyable for everyone.






SERVICE ANIMAL POLICY

Green Hills prioritizes the comfort, safety, and well-being of every guest. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), we welcome service animals that are individually trained to perform tasks for individuals with disabilities.


For the clarity and comfort of all visitors, please observe the following guidelines:

- Service Animals Only: Pets and emotional support animals—which are not considered service animals under the ADA—are not permitted on the grounds.
- Behavior & Control: Service animals must remain under the handler's control at all times and be leashed, harnessed, or tethered unless such equipment interferes with the animal's ability to perform its trained tasks.
- Handler Responsibilities: Handlers are responsible for supervising, caring for, and cleaning up after their service animal.
- Staff Inquiries: Staff may ask whether the animal is a service animal required due to a disability and what tasks it is trained to perform. We will never request documentation, require a demonstration, or ask for details about the handler's disability.

We have listened carefully to our families and understand the desire for meaningful ways to celebrate loved ones. While we warmly encourage the placement of flowers and personal decorations at your loved one's interment site, we ask for your partnership in following the guidelines provided. These updates reflect a thoughtful adjustment to long-standing rules and are intended to balance personal expression with the serene environment all visitors cherish.

We also ask that families remain mindful of nearby spaces and never place decorations beyond the boundaries of their own site. These guidelines help protect your items, ensure the grounds can be consistently cared for across 90 acres, and preserve a peaceful, respectful experience for every guest.

DECORATION & FLORAL GUIDELINES

Funeral Service Flowers

Flowers placed at the time of a Funeral Service will remain at the site for two (2) days.


We encourage families and guests to take any flowers they wish to keep at the conclusion of the service, ensuring these meaningful arrangements can continue to be enjoyed.

Holiday Decorations

During designated Holiday periods, 12" memorial fences and potted plants are permitted, and the 30" height restriction on decorations is temporarily lifted. Please note that these items will be removed once the Holiday period has concluded and regular guidelines resume.

Items Permitted Within the 30" Allowance

- Flowers – approved in-ground vases purchased through Green Hills
- Decorations under 30" tall
- Solar lights under 30" tall
- Statues and religious crosses under 30" tall

DECORATION & FLORAL GUIDELINES

- WHAT IS NEVER ALLOWED

Items included in the list below, as well as any items determined to pose a safety hazard, will be removed and disposed of.

- Fences – all sizes and lengths
- Lit Candles
- Potted Plants
- Rocks/Stones
- Food/Beverages left at an interment site
- Any items hung from trees, shrubs or plants
- Any large decorations over 30”, especially those encroaching upon other interment sites
- Please do not apply stickers, emblems, etc. to the front of crypts or niches as the adhesive will damage the crypt/niche. These items will be removed and discarded.
- Please do not hang any items from vases on wall crypts or niches.



Families are welcome to place flowers and decorations at their loved one's site; however, because these items are in a public setting, Green Hills cannot ensure their security or condition and is unable to reimburse or replace any items that may be lost, damaged, or removed.
